Dear Parents/Caregivers

As you are all now aware we have entered Level 3 lockdown for the next couple of days. At the moment, we are only open for children whose parents are essential workers. Today we have one bubble operating in Room 2. If you are an essential worker and need supervision for your child over the next 2 days, you will need to ring Jo in the office today to let her know that they will be attending school, as we will have to ensure we have enough teachers on site to cover the numbers. Please do not just turn up on the day as we will not be prepared for an increase in numbers, unless we have notice. All children attending school must be dropped off at 9am and collected at 3pm.

We will not be issuing devices for students to use at home over the next 2 days as we are hopeful that we will return to normal school attendance on Monday. However, if the lockdown continues next week, we will notify you about how you can access a device. If your child has a device at home, they can make contact with their teacher between 9am – 3pm, as they did in the previous lockdown so they can be provided with online learning.

Unfortunately, because the lockdown was so sudden, we will not be able to issue hard copy packs of work this week. In the meantime you can be reading to and with your child, getting them to keep a diary or descriptive writing, helping them to learn their tables etc.

We will have to postpone our disco that was due to take place on Friday afternoon. Once we have rescheduled, we will inform you of the date.
